Question 1

Q: What kind of edge should the scratcher be?

A: The Scratcher should have a smooth edge.

Question 2

Q: When was the last job for scratchers. Was it the same quantities? What company was the winning bidder? What was the winning bid total?

A: The South Carolina Education Lottery (SCEL) last procured this type of "Doubloon Scratchers" in late 2010 with delivery in early 2011 of 50,000 Scratchers. The winning vendor was Amadeo Enterprises from Arabi, LA. The lowest bid was \$8,850 with shipping.

Question 3

Q: Are the Blue and Green PMS colors specified in the solicitation the same blue and green colors that were used on the previous coin scratchers?

A: Yes. (Blue: PMS 286; and Green: PMS 361)

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Question 4

Q: On page 4 of the Solicitation's "Scope of Work," under #2's Delivery section, it states "The preferred pallet size is 4'W x 4'L x 4'T." What does the "T" mean in "4'W x 4'L x 4'T?"

A: The "T" means "Tall" or "Height." The two (2) terms, tall or height, may be used interchangeably.

Question 5

Q: Is the imprint color white?

A: No, the raised area of detail produced by the die is the same surface color aluminum of the doubloons. (Blue: PMS 286; and Green: PMS 361)
