**A: NOTE: The procurement type is a Fixed Price Bid NOT a Request For
Proposals. No proposals are being requested. Yes, as the preferred method
of receiving graphics is via Electronic Transfer, vendors may be outside the
USA; however, as vendors may need to come to attend meeting(s) at the SCEL
Office in Columbia, S.C., vendors should be aware that the individual vendor
would be responsible for transportation costs. See Question 7.**

Q: Can we submit the proposals via email?

A: NOTE: The procurement type is a Fixed Price Bid NOT a Request For Proposals. No proposals are being requested. This question has already been answered. See Question 8 in ATTACHMENT 2018 MAY on SCEL's Procurement Webpage.

Vendors should monitor the website to check for amendments and will need to acknowledge they had the opportunity to read any amendments posted when sending their quote. There are several ways to acknowledge an amendment. Vendors may also 3) sign and return the amendment or 4) acknowledge by letter.
