Question 1

Q: At the top of the solicitation, under “Quality,” 1,000 and 3,000 signs are requested. At the bottom, the amounts of 1,000 and 2,000 signs are requested. Which amounts are correct?

A: The South Carolina Education Lottery (SCEL) it would like to receive bids for the **cost of producing 1,000 signs AND for producing 2,000 signs** in order to make a price comparison as to which amount is most beneficial to SCEL, should the decision be made to use a different substrate the next time jackpot signs are procured.

Question 2

Q: The Request For Information (RFI) mentions that a blue/yellow pole sign from several years ago experienced fading. Would it be possible to view the jackpot sign art to see the colors used?

A: Yes. Below is a copy of the draft art. The white boxes hold the places for where j-channels will hold jackpot numbers.

Question 3

Q: As the Request For Information (RFI) does not provide a shipping address, is it necessary to provide shipping costs?

A: No. It is not necessary to providing shipping costs. On the updated form below, the shipping row has been stricken.

Question 4

Q: If the sign will need to be updated several times a week as the jackpot amounts change, should I include a price for adding GROMMETS to the signs?

A: Previous hanging jackpot signs made out of styrene have not needed grommets, but it is possible that coroplast signs will benefit from having grommets. Please provide your reasoning as to whether grommets would extend the useful life of the substrate you are recommending. An updated bid sheet has been added at the end to provide space to add grommet pricing.


