Display the Top Prizes Remaining Report: Every morning when you sign in the terminal will generate a "Top Prizes Remaining" report. Post this updated report in the clear sleeve or change mat on your counter. The clear sleeve must be

station. Encourage players to read the information, but discourage them from removing this resource.

The Surfside Beach winner told lottery officials that the clerk at the Circle K handed him two $\$ 20$ tickets. But he only had enough cash to buy one of them. When he won $\$ 20$ on his ticket he used the winnings to buy the other ticket that the clerk offered him. It won him the $\$ 2$ million prize.
"I was in the perfect place at the perfect time," he said. "I'm so thankful it happened."

The winner plans to invest his prize money, as does the Myrtle Beach millionaire.

He's retiring sooner than expected after his win. "I'm not making any big purchases," the winner told lottery officials. "I'm investing it, so I can knock some years off my retirement."

And he almost didn't buy the ticket. He was on his way home from Costco when he changed his mind and ran inside the Food Lion for a Powerball® ticket and decided to try the Lottery's new $\$ 20$ scratch-off too

He texted his wife a photo of his winning ticket. She was at work when she saw it, and just like her husband, she's not working for as long as she thought either.

Four more top prizes of $\$ 2$ million remain to be won. If you sell one of them, that's a $\$ 20,000$ bonus for your store!
