# THAT'S A WRAP: Country Store Was Ready for One Last Close Up

These days Bruce and Mary Jane Wood are enjoying life on the farm, but for 28 years the couple ran MJ's Country Stop on Fairview Rd. in Batesburg.

You might have seen their country store. It was featured in a commercial for last year's *Carolina Jackpot* and *Clemson Jackpot* tickets.

The ad was sort of like a last hurrah for the place. The couple sold the business and semi-retired shortly after the spot was filmed.

With this year's \$5 Carolina and Clemson scratch-offs about to drop on Tuesday, August 5, we wanted to catch up with the former lottery retailers to see what it was like seeing their family-fun convenience store on television.

"It was pretty neat," said Bruce. "Folks that came in all the time recognized the store."

In the ad, "Carl" walks through the door and is greeted by "Fred," who is working behind the

counter. As the two chit chat, we learn Carl is a regular customer, whose daughter is deciding where to go to college. Their biases are obvious. Carl is wearing a Clemson hat. Fred is wearing a Gamecock one. In the end Carl, who always buys a Clemson scratch-off, takes a Carolina one instead, signaling the choice his daughter has made.

It's a sweet story, and the atmosphere inside MJ's Country Stop is what helped to make it a great, award winning ad for the Lottery.

The sound of the bell ringing as the customer walks through the door, the light from the sun streaking through the windows, the hand-placed letters on the menu board and even the glow from the neon signs made the commercial feel authentic, it felt like South Carolina.

Bruce, Mary Jane and their family must have thought of their life there every time they caught the ad on television. Maybe it brought

back memories of Bruce greeting customers, Mary Jane fixing food at the grill or their son-in-law selling lottery tickets from the dispenser.

Sound familiar?

Soon, you'll be receiving the new *Carolina Jackpot* and *Clemson Jackpot* tickets. Bragging rights on this year's tickets are worth up to \$200,000 and two Players' Club member will win up to \$100,000 in the second-chance promotion.

The scratch-offs go on sale a few weeks ahead of both schools highly-anticipated college football openers. The Tigers meet LSU on Friday, August 30 at 7:30 p.m. and the Gamecocks will face Virginia Tech at 3 p.m. on Saturday, August 31.

Bruce told us he supports the Gamecocks and the Tigers, so he'll be pulling for them both. And before our conversation drew to a close, Bruce asked the Lottery its plans for a commercial this year.

"I thought maybe you'd run ours again," he joked.

Well Bruce, that is exactly what we are going to do.

The PALMETTO SERIES is the annual points competition between CAROLINA and CLEMSON sponsored by the Lottery. When the rivals face off this season, each will earn a point for a win, with the overall winner taking home the Palmetto Series trophy.


# A Fun Spot to Play the Lottery in Walterboro
